No specification of the edition, With cadenza (1) 1st mov. from Mozart Violin Concerto No.3 G-dur K.216 (2) 1st mov. from Mozart Violin Concerto No.4 D-dur K.218 (3) 1st mov. from Mozart Violin Concerto No.5 A-dur K.219</p> <p>[B] First or Third movement from a piece selected from the Romantic period or a piece from a later period. (Not acceptable a slow movement)</p> <p><u>Orchestral Excerpts</u> HSO sent to your address within 1week before the audition.</p>

Sent your resume paper to HSO office. (Not acceptable by e-mail or FAX.)3b. For only applicant not live in Japan, Sending resume by e-mail is acceptable.
Deadline	Friday, March 8, 2019 - Application must be received by the deadline. Post mark dated will not be accepted.
Note	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Schedule detail will be sent with orchestral excerpts after the deadline.- All costs such as travel expenses have to be covered by applicant.- Please bring your own accompanist for the performance of the required piece.- Secondary audition is only open to those who pass the primary auditions.
